

Badin Water Project Winding Down



After two years of work, the replacement of the town's public water system is near completion. Street paving and concrete restoration is currently underway.

Stanly County Utilities Director, Donna Davis also voices gratitude to Badin citizens for their patience.

"It has been a demanding process but overall successful. The remaining asphalt, concrete and restoration work is scheduled to be complete before

Thanksgiving."

With just a couple of streets remaining in need of curb, gutter, sidewalk and pavement, the overall impact of restoration will soon be evident.
